Each one of Lynda's pieces is made entirely by hand. From throwing & hand building to glazing & firing, Lynda creates every pot individually. She has developed as a functional potter but also enjoys using some sculptural techniques in conjunction with throwing. This offers a sort of freedom with the clay & gives a quirky, fluid, almost off balance effect to her white crackle range of candelabras & 'drunk pots'.

## Breeogue Pottery



Nestled in beautiful landscape, between Knocknarea Mountain & Ballisodare Bay, the studio & gallery takes its name from the townland of Breeogue, which is 4 miles from Sligo. Here in a converted old stone building, Grainne MacLoughlin produces a high - fired stoneware table - top range as well as contemporary lighting. She applies various layers of different coloured glazes over her simple & uncomplicated vessels.

In the final firing (1280°C), the glazes react with each other, resulting in exciting swirling patterns, reminiscent of images found in nature. Grainne also welcomes corporate & private commissions and specialises in baby feet impressions in clay - an ideal present for babies & small children. Gift vouchers are available.

Working from sketches & photographs of river banks, bogs & landscapes, he incises these images onto soft clay forms & then uses an ancient Japanese glazing technique called "raku" which produces an array of rich, iridescent colours & hues. His richly adorned & freely formed tiles & platters have a quirky & spontaneous nature.

Tom also embellishes his pieces with sculpted images of fauna, in particular birds & hares. Tom supplies galleries in Ireland, UK and the USA. He has undertaken & welcomes individual & corporate commissions.
